Safety

To align with the recommendations of D90 Safety Committee, beginning during the 2019-20 school year, **all school visitors venturing past the main office will be required to leave some form of personal identification in the main office and to wear a school visitor badge.**

Additionally, in partnership with the River Forest Police and Fire Departments, all students and faculty practice safety drills throughout the school year (Fire Drill, Lockdown Drill, Severe Weather Drill, Earthquake Drill).

- Curb-side Principal service is on Park Ave
- Students should exit on the passenger side

<p>Late Lunch Cart</p>	<p>No worries if your child forgets their lunch at home. Late lunches can be dropped on the “Late Lunch Cart” in the Park Ave. Lobby.</p>
<p>Food/Snack/ Water</p>	<p>Students are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle to school each day. Please see specific classroom snack guidelines from your child's teacher. A list of approved classroom snacks is attached here and is in the D90 Student/Family Handbook.</p>
<p>Classroom Parties</p>	<p>To align with the recommendations of the D90 Allergy and Wellness Policy, beginning this school year food will no longer be served during classroom parties or at anytime in the classroom outside of classroom snack times.</p>
<p>Safe Routes to School</p>	<p>When walking or biking to school, all students/adults should only cross streets at crosswalks and when appropriate with crossing guards. Attached here is the Safe Routes to School audit, outlining the safest routes to school for students in D90.</p>
<p>Arrival/Dismissal</p>	<p>Student arrival is between 8:05-8:20 daily. There are Lincoln Staff supervisors stationed on both the Franklin and Park entrances daily.</p> <p>Additionally staff is stationed during afternoon dismissal in the same areas from 3:10-3:25. At 3:25 bell any students yet to be picked will be escorted to the main office.</p>
