Then and Now Photos:

Field Day:

On Thursday, June 10, Lincoln will hold a "Covid-Style" Field Day. This event will be for students and school personnel only.

T-Shirts:

4th Grade Lincoln T-shirts will be distributed and worn by the 4th graders on Friday, June 11.

4th Grade Picnic:

On Friday, June 11, 4th graders will take a short walking Field Trip to Keystone park for a 4th grade picnic. Due to Covid protocols, this event will be for 4th graders and school personnel only. Masks and physical distancing will be honored. A rain date has been set for Wednesday, June 9.

Clap-Out:

We will hold a Lincoln School student only Clap-Out indoors at the end of the day on June 11 right at dismissal. 4th graders will walk the halls of Lincoln one last time being "Clapped Out".

Green4Good Planting:

In conjunction with our Green4Good committee, we've purchased a native plant for each 4th grader that they will be planting next week on the Lincoln School grounds.

Music Performance:

Ms. Mann has been working with our 4th graders preparing a special music performance that will be shared virtually with all families.

Slide Show:

The traditional 4th grade slideshow, composed of photos that 4th grade families have been sharing, will be viewed by the 4th graders on Friday, June 11. The link will also be shared with families afterward.

Mr. Garstki-Ms. Steketee:

On Thursday, May 27, Roosevelt Middle School Principal, Mr. Garstki, and Assistant Principal, Ms. Steketee, will be visiting the classrooms at Lincoln to meet with the 4th graders and answer their questions about life at Roosevelt!
