Dear Parents and Guardians,

I am writing today to let you know I am excited to get the Rainbows program started again this year. As many of you may already know, Rainbows consists of peer-support groups for children who have experienced a significant loss. This loss may involve a separation, divorce, death, or other difficult transition. The group is open to all Lincoln students, and it gives the children an opportunity to work through their feelings and come to an increased acceptance of the life-changes they are experiencing.

The program offers assistance in the following areas: (1) understanding and acceptance of feelings, (2) improved self-esteem, (3) learning to trust others, and (4) putting words to what has happened.

I plan on beginning Rainbows meetings at the end of October. After I receive everyone's permission slips, I will form groups based on the student's grade level. Each group should have five or fewer students to ensure that each child receives individual attention and support. The groups will meet during recess time once a week until the spring, probably on Tuesdays or Wednesdays.
